New home numbers steady in 2025

New single-family home construction is the same this year in Sherburne County townships for the first eight months of 2025.

A report compiled by the Sherburne County Planning and Zoning Dept. shows through the end of August, the county has issued 45 building permits for new single-family home construction, the exact same number as in 2024. That number was 40 in 2023 after a better year in 2022 with 69.

The 2025 report does not include Baldwin and Becker Twp. Both jurisdictions control their own planning and zoning projects.

New home construction is sometimes stronger in late summer through the fall, and numbers are expected to pick up throughout the rest of the year. In 2023 and in 2024, the townships finished the year with 95 new homes built.

So far through the end of August, Big Lake has had the most permits issued for new homes with 15, compared with nine in 2024.

Orrock Twp. is next with 12. The town-

ship had 15 this time a year ago. Palmer Twp. is next with six permits, the same as in 2024. New home permits in the remaining townships so far in 2024 are: Clear issued 205 permits for Lake (5), Livonia (4), Santiago (2), Blue Hill (1) and Haven (0). Valuation for those new homes ranged from a of low \$70,000 to a high of

for new single-family homes. Homeowners and business owners were busy with other projects to improve and repair their properties. As a result of spring storms, the county

> roofing jobs and another 104 for new siding. Some of those projects are still in progress.

> > There were 89 permits to build accessorv buildings like pole sheds and storage sheds.

Another 41 permits were issued for finishing basements, and 23 more permits for building additions to existing homes.

There were lots of permits (152) to replace windows and doors, 36 to build decks, five for swimming pools and 10 for residential solar electric installations.

There were 115 permits pulled to upgrade gas, heating and cooling systems, and 86 more to install or replace septic systems.

The final numbers for 2025 for all townships and cities will be available in early

Organizational tips for bathrooms and laundry spaces

No two homes are exactly alike.

While homes typically feature certain common amenities, even in planned communities homeowners do their best to set their homes apart from others in the development.

Certain areas of a home may initially garner less attention than others. This often is the case with small washrooms, sometimes called powder rooms or guest bathrooms, as well as laundry areas. Despite their utilitarian nature, bathrooms and laundry rooms can often benefit from some better organization. The following are some ways to maximize storage and function in these spaces.

Bathroom

Apart from a vanity and possibly a medicine cabinet, many bathroom layouts tend to be pretty sparse in terms of storage. So it is up to homeowners to introduce more storage and organizational function.

• Over-toilet shelving: Freestanding units are available from many different retailers, but they may lack aesthetic appeal. Homeowners can install open shelves above the toilet that coordinate with the style of the home. Use them to store extra towels or dis-

play decorative items.

- Streamlined containers: Invest in coordinating storage containers (clear are preferable) so that all items can be uniformly put away. First sort through all items to determine which size containers are necessary and how many are required.
- Conceal toilet paper: Homeowners want to have bath tissue on hand, but simply placing it near the toilet can look cluttered or unsightly. Use decorative baskets to house one or two extra rolls and place on shelving or on the toilet tank itself.
- Freestanding cabinet: Those lucky enough to have linen closets in their bathrooms can keep everything behind closed doors. In small bathrooms this may not be possible. However, a freestanding cabinet, similar to a kitchen pantry cabinet, can be used if there is space for it. Store all of the linens and other items inside.

Laundry

Laundry rooms can be very organized or a catch-all space for objects that simply do not fit in other rooms in the home. Perfect-

ing laundry room organization can take some effort.

- Folding station: A laundry room is more useful with a folding station. It can be a separate counter over cabinetry, or innovative homeowners build a counter over front-loading washing machines and dryers.
- <u>Utilize wall space</u>: Use hooks and shelving to get items off the floor or counters. Use them to hold brooms, mops, ironing boards, detergent, and much more.
 - Invest in a pedestal storage drawer:

Laundry pedestal storage drawers can be used to keep dryer sheets, laundry pods and additional supplies out of view.

• <u>Use space-saving cabinetry:</u> Pull out drawers and cabinets can be used to hold hampers, ironing boards, and other frequently used items without cluttering up the room.

Organizing bathrooms and wash rooms can give these spaces a cleaner, more impressive look.



Professionals might be returning to work in offices after years of pandemic-related remote work, but that doesn't mean home buyers aren't still prioritizing home office space when shopping for a new place to call their own. According to a recent survey of home buyers conducted by the National Association of Home Builders, 66 percent would prefer to buy a home with exactly one home office space and 13 percent want at least two offices. Just one in five buyers indicated they do not want any home office space. The majority of buyers who want home office space prefer a medium-sized space, which the NAHB defined as between 100 and 150 square feet. Just 22 percent of buyers prefer a home office space larger than 150 square feet, while only 19 percent want a small space (less than 100 square feet). The NAHB survey indicates the enduring popularity of home office spaces, recognition of which can be particularly useful for current homeowners preparing to put their homes on the market as well as those looking to add office space.

Big Lake commercial growth booming

Big Lake is continuing to expand and grow as several expansions, developments and buildouts in the past year, mostly in commercial.

For the City of Big Lake, here are developments that have occurred or will occur within 2024-2025:

- Covenant Christian Academy opened their doors north of Premier Marine. They are providers of exceptional classical Christian education and work in partnership with parents to build foundations for lifelong learners and devoted followers of Jesus;
- Rawr Organics is constructing an approximately 17,000 sq. ft. facility in the Industrial Park to manufacture protein bars. Rawr Bar launched in June of 2018 in a Minneapolis Farmer's Market;
- White Bear Clothing purchased an Industrial Park parcel for a business expansion project to construct an approximately 40,000 sq. ft warehouse. They provide premium fleece, outerwear and performance apparel to embroiderers, screen printers, promotional products distributors, uniform retailers and athletic dealers:
- City Council and Big Lake Township approved a development contract with **M&M Precision Machining** to construct an approximately 60,000 sq. ft. manufacturing facility in the Industrial Park. M & M Precision Machining is dedicated to providing superior CNC machining solutions with a focus on quality, reliability, and customer partnership;
- Mega Storage completed their largescale self-storage facility near Lisi Medical south of Hwy. 10. Mega Storage is a state-ofthe-art facility specializing in boat, RV and contractor storage;
- Aeon completed **Goldenrod Glen**, a 74-unit multifamily senior living facility. Nestled in the scenic and vibrant community of Big Lake, Goldenrod Glen offers affordable, independent living for households with at least one adult aged 55 or older;
- **Prairie Meadows 4th Addition**, east of 172nd Street, continues to be built out by Cavaliera Homes. The development consists of 60 twin homes;
- **Prairie Meadows 5th Addition,** west of 172nd Street, received Preliminary Plat approval for 99-single family homes;
- **Big Lake Car Condos** (east of 168th Street) completed their final phase of luxury garage condominiums. Whether the space is used as a personal garage, workshop, private office, urban cabin or just a place to get
